
Student: Using Breakout Rooms


How to use breakout rooms in GP7

To Go to the Breakout Room:



- When your teacher activates breakout rooms, you will be able to see what team you are assigned to.
- The Breakout Room Docs section at the bottom tells you what slides/documents your teacher has made available for your use in the breakout.
- Click **Breakout Room** to the right of your team name to go to the breakout room.


How to Use Breakout Rooms:




- Note that, once you enter the breakout room, the room name at the top changes to your team name (in yellow).
- Click the Open Mic button to use your microphone. When done speaking, click the same button (now called Mute Me) to turn off your mic.
- Click the Ask Help button to get your teacher's attention and ask for help. She can then either talk to you
 from the main classroom or join you in the breakout room. Once you receive help, click the Ask Help
 button again to stop notifying your teacher.
- Click the **Back to Main Room** button to return to the main classroom.

To Use Slides in the Breakout Rooms:

Before a slide can be used in the breakout room, a student must make themselves the presenter and share
the slide. Any student can become presenter by clicking the Become Presenter button.



 The presenter now has the option to click the Open button to open the slide(s) that the teacher made available in the Breakout Room Docs section.



- The student presenter is able to use annotation tools to type, write, and draw on the whiteboard.
- To give all students the ability to annotate the whiteboard, the student presenter must click the **Allow Guests to Draw** button (highlighted in green) at the top left corner of the whiteboard.
- Once finished annotating a slide, the student presenter should click the **Save Edits & Freeze Shapes** button just below the allow guests to draw button. This will save a copy of that slide in the Breakout Room Docs, so the teacher can share your slides with the class in the main classroom. Each slide must be saved before returning to the main classroom. If the student presenter attempts to return to the main classroom before saving each slide, they will get a warning that they are leaving without saving all slides.
